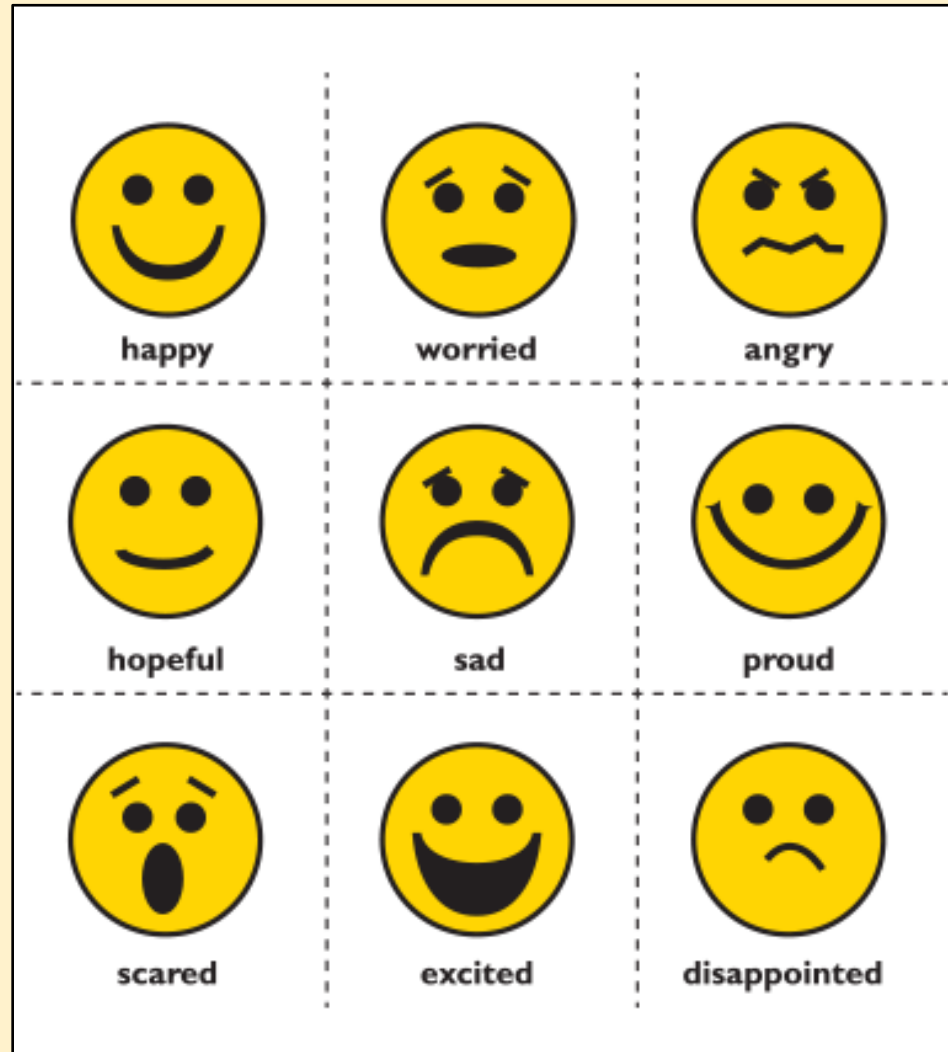


Refugees had to flee their country

How do you think Paddington Bear felt when he arrived in the UK from Peru?

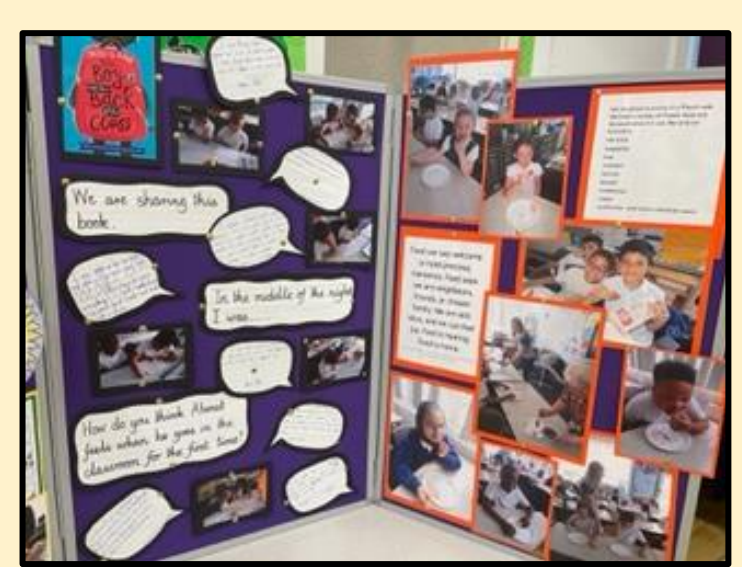
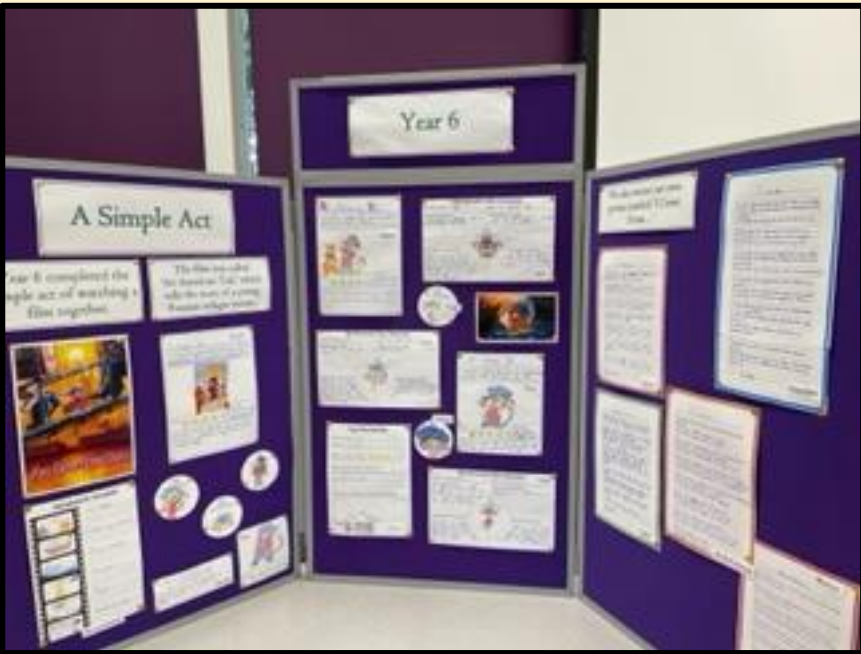




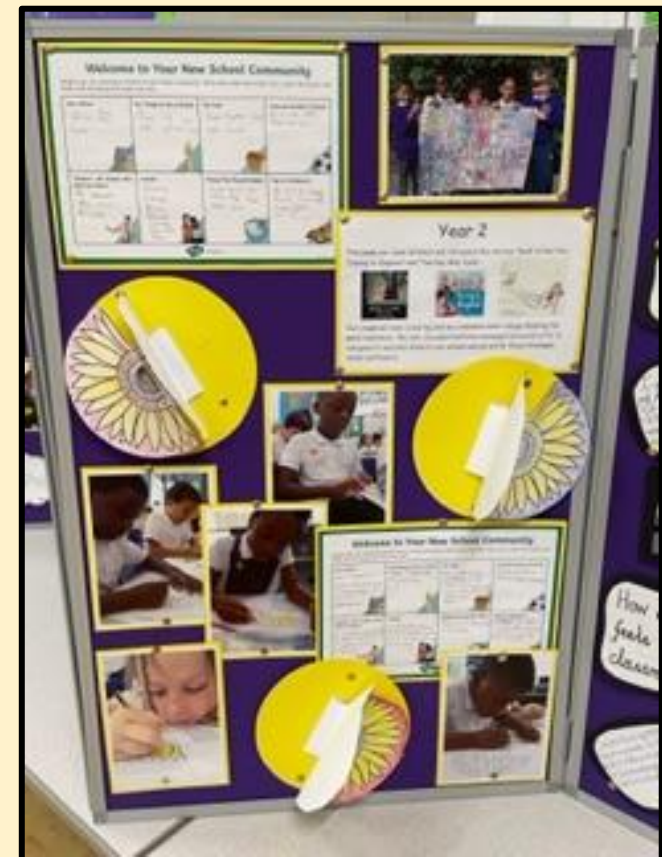
