Life really is a rollercoaster! Here is to the summer term being the best term ever for the pupils, staff and the community.



Our science topic has been all about minibeasts and their habitats. The children have written fact files about different invertebrates and have been on a minibeast hunt to find out where they prefer to live. They will be designing their own bug hotel.

Our history topic has been all about the changing face of nursing through the years. The children have learned about the lives of Mary Seacole and Edith Cavell.





# Year 3





The second half of the Spring term started with a morning experience on the Stone Age which brought the topic alive for us. 




### Year 4

- In PSHE we have been discussing health and have learned about the recovery position. Maybe your child can show you how to do this at home!














# Year 6
