But all they could say was, 'Cluck, cluck, cluck, cluck.'

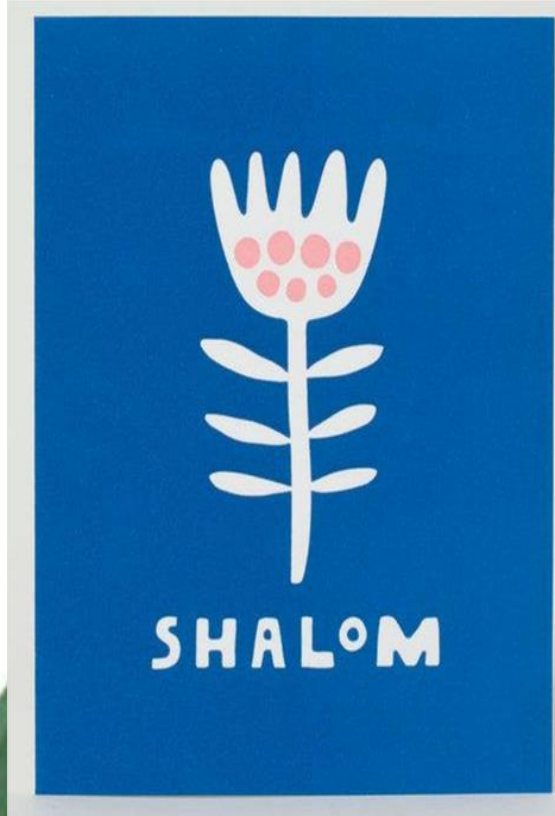





5. The animals stood in the stable,
