Easter themed games



Easter Bunny Tig



A great Easter-themed game for a gym lesson.

Instructions

- Select one child to be tigger. They will remain the tigger for the duration of the game.
- . The children will run around the area, trying to avoid being tigged.
- Once tigged, the child pretends to be the Easter Bunny by using their hands to make bunny ears on the top
 of their head and by jumping or hopping on the spot.
- . To be set free, another child runs up to them and pretends to be an Easter Bunny too.
- . For added challenge, add more than one figger.
- To extend the game, rotate the tiggers.

Bunny, Bunny, Easter Bunny!



A great Easter-themed warm up or cool down game.

This game follows the same rules as the popular game 'Duck, Duck, Goose! but uses the wording 'Bunny, Bunny, Easter Bunny!'

Instructions

- Sit children in one large circle.
- Selectione child.
- Instruct child to walk round the outside of the circle, placing their hand on each child's head as they
 pass them. They say 'Bunny' when touching a child's head. If they want a child to chase them they say
 'Easter Bunny'.
- When being chased, the child must try to run the whole way around the circle and sit back in the spot where
 the child who was chasing them was sitting.
- If they make it the whole way around and sit down without being caught, they win.
- If they get caught by their chaser before they sit down, the chaser is the winner.
- The chaser now walks around the outside of the circle, placing their hand on each child's head calling 'Bunnu' or 'Easter Bunnu'.
- Continue the game until all children have had a turn.

Easter Egg Toss



A great Easter-themed game for a PE lesson.

Instructions

- . Split children into groups of 4.
- · Ask each group to line up behind a cone.
- · Give each group 3 plastic eggs or small soft balls.
- Each group should stand behind a cone and be facing a basket (or box, tub, etc).
- Each child tries to throw the 3 eggs into the basket. They collect the balls after throwing all three and then
 pass them onto the next person in their queue.
- The next person attempts to throw all 3 eggs into the basket. Repeat until everyone has had a turn.
- For every egg they get in the basket, the children get a point.
- · The winning group is the group with the most points.

Challenge

· Children only get one egg to throw.

· Move the basket further away from the cone.

· Give the game allotted time.
