In Year Admissions

An in-year admission is the admission of a pupil to school which takes place outside the normal entry times. This includes pupils changing schools, pupils coming from a different country or from other parts of the UK, pupils returning to a school from living elsewhere or those who have not been in school.

In Birmingham Local Authority schools are responsible for their own in-year admissions.

At Welsh House Farm Community School we offer places providing our PAN (pupil admission number) for a class does not exceed 30.

If there is a waiting list for a class and a place becomes available the criteria for the offer of a place is as follows:

- Looked After Children or children who have ceased to be looked after through adoption;
- Children with siblings already at the school;
- Children living closest to the school (Birmingham Local Authority provides the distance measure).
